# **INTRODUCTION:**

## **PREPARING TO PRAY:**

Prayer is about spending time with our Father, trusting Him, acknowledging His greatness and our need for Him, focusing our thoughts, and glorifying our Father as we pray before going through specific, targeted prayer requests.

# **HOW TO PRAY:**

#### **Confession:**

Means admitting and agreeing with God about the sin in our lives, confessing it, and turning away from all things that dishonor God. *"Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy."* Proverbs 28:13

#### **Adoration:**

Means worship; recognizing and acknowledging God for who He is. "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name! ... The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love." Psalm 103:1, 8

#### Thanksgiving:

Means thankful; spending time with God and thanking Him for the forgiveness of sins, the blessing of being His child, and the privilege of serving Him. *"I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds." Psalm 9:1* 

#### **Supplication:**

Means request – making requests to God on behalf of others, praying for God's will in the lives of family, extended family and friends, people in your sphere of influence: school, workplace, and neighborhood, as well as people around the world. "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God." Philippians 4:6
