Vision:

Join us as we serve alongside Commissioned International in Honduras. During this trip, your family will serve in a children's home that provides food, shelter, education, and loving care for vulnerable children. Families will build meaningful relationships with the children, support local staff and volunteers, and share the hope of Jesus through everyday interactions and intentional ministry. We will also intentionally focus on discipling your family around God's mission. This trip is designed to help your family grow together as you experience God's love for communities both near and far and step outside your everyday environment to serve in meaningful ways.

We believe that one day, people from every tribe, tongue, and nation will worship God around His throne. Honduras is home to over 10 million people, many of whom live in remote areas. While Catholicism has been the dominant religion for generations, the number of evangelical believers has been steadily growing. This momentum is encouraging, but many still lack a clear understanding of the Gospel and a personal relationship with Jesus. Through this trip, your family will have a unique opportunity to invest in the next generation—caring for children and pointing them toward a life-transforming relationship with Jesus.

What's Expected:

As a team member serving alongside our partners in Honduras, you will play a vital role in caring for children and sharing the hope of the Gospel with them.

Expectations include:

- **Serving** - A heavy part of this trip is serving in the children's home. Be prepared to share the Gospel with children, provide care for them, and support the local staff and volunteers.

- **Maintain flexibility** - Scheduled activities are subject to change due to various factors so maintaining a spirit of flexibility allows you to be open to any changes God may have for your team.
- **Care** - Serving on a short-term mission trip is a great way to serve and care for our long-term missionaries. Offering to cook a meal, watching their children so they can go out, cleaning, game nights, etc., are all great ways to care for our missionaries on the field.
- **Show Up** - Be present for all pre-trip and post-trip meetings as well as all in-country activities. We want you to make the most of your time as you engage the nations with the hope of the gospel.

Requirements

- **Prerequisites**
 - Must have a valid passport with at least six months of validity remaining when traveling internationally.
 - Must get any vaccinations required by the government.
 - Adults: Must complete kids ministry training and a background check.
- **Responsibilities**
 - Carry yourself at all times as a disciple of Jesus Christ.
 - Engage with people from other cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds.
 - Comfortability initiating and facilitating spiritual conversations.
 - Commitment to hearing from God through his Word on your decision to go on this trip.
 - Support-raising - It is your responsibility to fundraise the total amount required for your trip.
- **Medications**

- **Passport**
